



**MISHCAT CO:** CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Mishcat Co rugs are eco friendly and green. Using recycled yarn for our sari silk carpets is an integral part of our holistic design philosophy, to protect and respect which we request our patrons to follow the below mentioned care instructions closely:

- 1.** Partial carpet fibre shedding is initially expected upon cleaning and will taper off within the first month.
- 2.** This is due to the fact that carpets are made from recycled sari yarn: which includes bits and pieces of gota, chanderi, and mixes of different silks of traditional styles and crafts of Indian sari making. These silk fibres are slippery, and varied in texture- and when rubbed against each other during time of initial cleaning, can shed.
- 3.** No brush should not be used for cleaning. No mechanical rotary brush.
- 4.** Instead, a smooth metallic head can be used with a slit suction.
- 5.** It should be ensured that during the time of mopping, floor should be completely dry before the rug is put back in place. Care should be taken to avoid contact with any chemicals, including cleaning chemicals.
- 6.** Dampness should be avoided completely. If a little water spills on the rug, please swab with a dry cloth to remove as soon as possible. The longer water sits in the rug, the more harmful it can be.
- 7.** Professional rug cleaners are recommended for periodic cleaning.
